A bit more information: Check your passports NOW. Kenya requires all guests to have passports that are valid for 6 months after their departure date from Kenya. In other words, your passport must be valid through May 2023. If yours isn't, renew it NOW! The Passport Office is backed up and it can take 3-4 months to have your paperwork processed. You will need your passport to get your Kenyan Visa. That will also take a bit of time, but it's only valid for 90 days so we'll talk

about that a bit later. The cost of that Visa is \$51 and you'll need 2 passport photos for that. Again, we'll get into details later.
