Next week I’ll send along the price and the number of Trekkers we’ll need to lower that price!!! The more the merrier!!! :>)

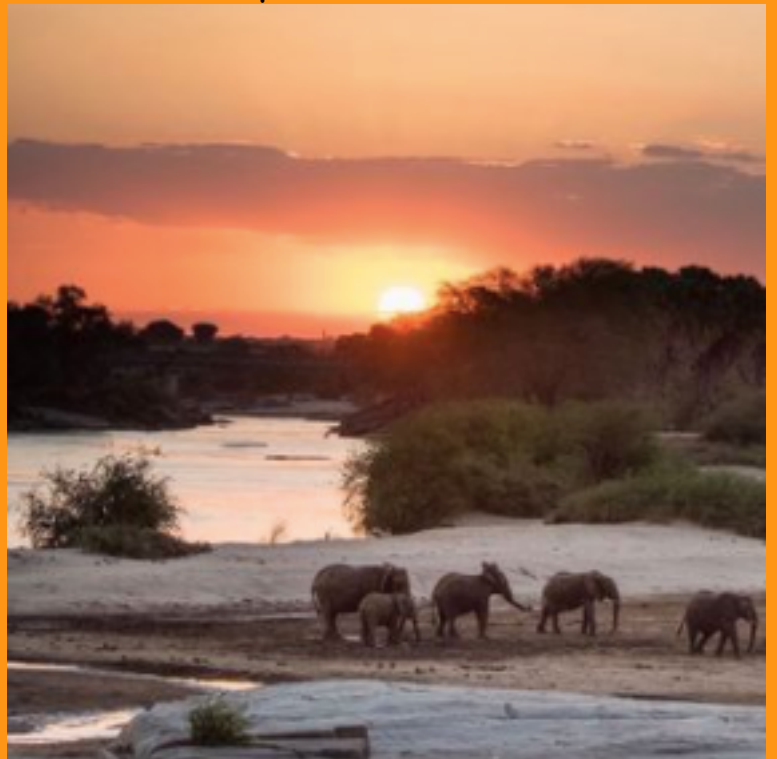
