If only we could take ALL our belongings along - the way this tortoise does! LOL!!! Full list to follow as we near our departure.

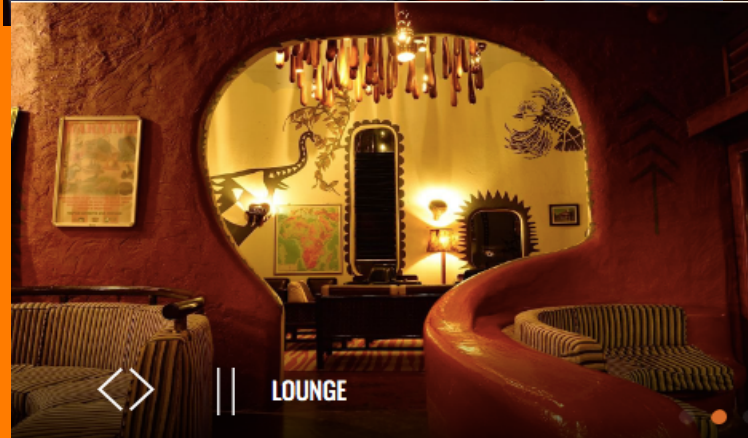
