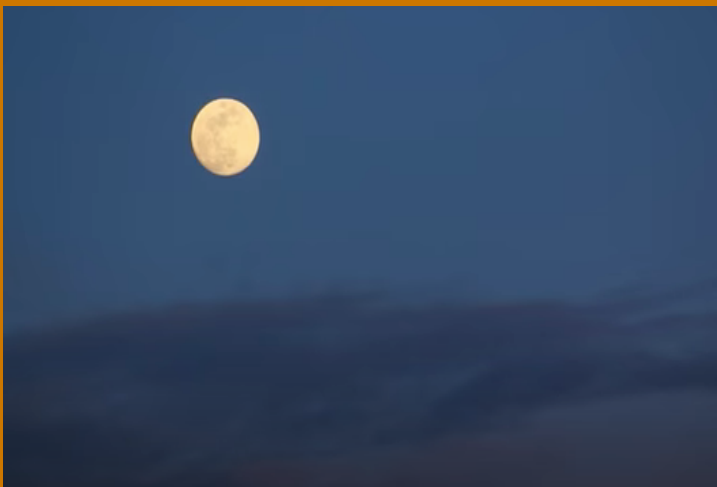
KENYA
