
KENYA! Land of Mystery and Marvels!!!

JAMBO and Good morning, all!

As you're considering joining our group, there are a few things you will need: <u>**Passport**</u> – they're good for 10 years now, so if you've never had one, now is the time to apply. You should be able to pick up an application at any Post Office. You'll need 2 passport photos to go with the application. If you're an AAA member, they can take them at their office OR most CVS stores will also take passport photos. A <u>VISA</u> will be required to enter Kenya. No, not the credit card!

LOL !!! Although the credit card is

accepted in Kenya. Kenyan VISAs are only valid for 90 days, so we'll apply for them a bit closer to departure date - once we have that! You can get all the information, including a VISA application, on line when the time comes. You will need a passport photo for your VISA and your passport must be valid for at least 6 months from the date you arrive in Kenya. You'll also need a ticket showing when you plan to leave. More about that once we know WHEN we're going! :>)
