As of this writing, entry requirements for Kenya are a Visa and a negative Covid PCR test taken within 72 hours of arrival. You will also need a negative PCR test prior to departure for re-entry into the US. We hope those requirements are lifted by September 2022. Anti-malaria protection (pills) are suggested and you should discuss that with your doctor. Personally, I've never seen a mosquito in Kenya, but better safe than sorry! No other vaccinations are required for entry into Kenya. Just in case, every bed is fitted with mosquito netting. This is a Genet, which means "Heaven" in Africa.
