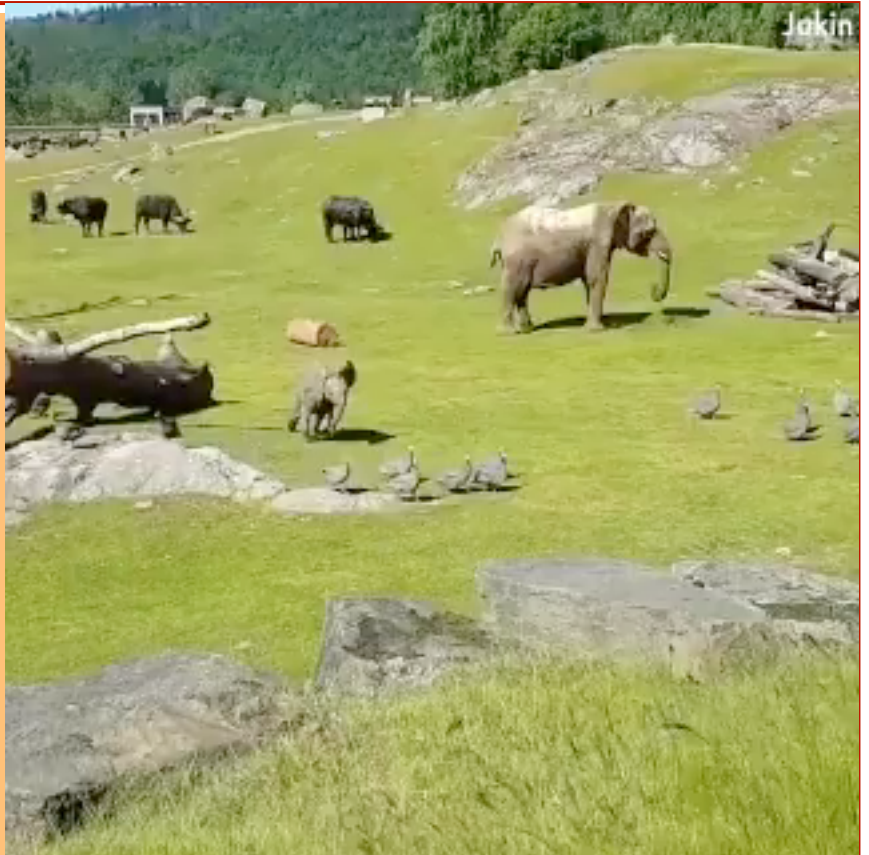


We may come upon a scene such as this ... get those cameras ready! LOL!!!
