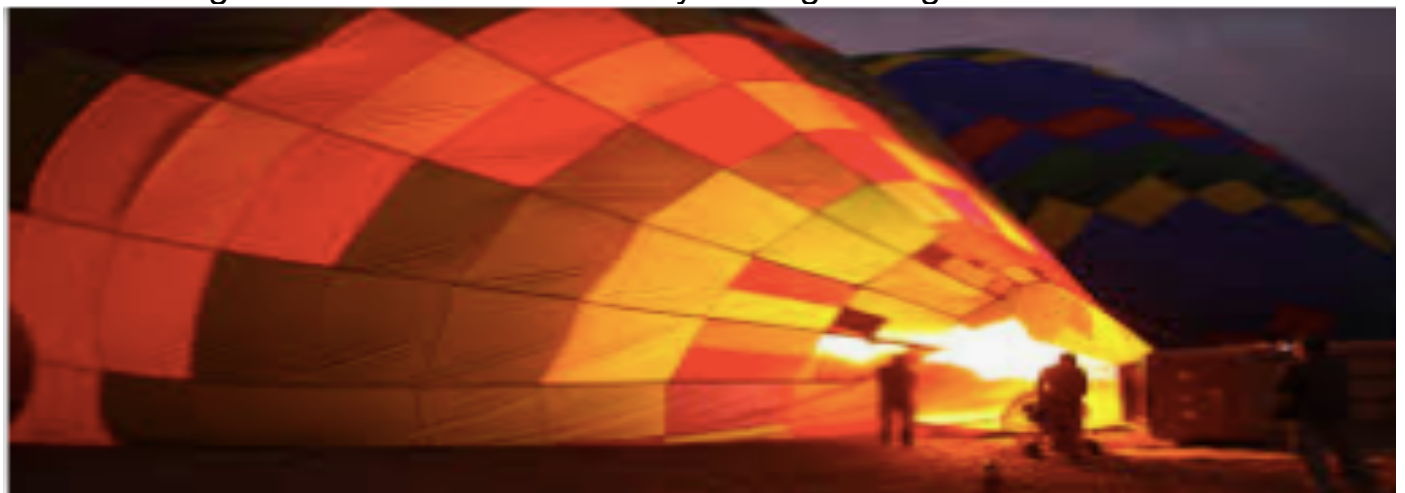
Hope you all enjoyed the Super Bowl and that your team won ...

It's easy to understand Kenya's appeal. Kenya also has a very temperate year-round climate that makes it traveler friendly. Warm to hot days and cool to cold nights.

Another spectacular way to view Kenya is from a hot air balloon. Expensive, but worth it!
