Day 3 – Wednesday, 05 March Sorrento – Walking Tour




Day 5 - Friday, 07 March

### Sorrento





A relaxation of the mind and body await in the Spa Romamor in which the atmosphere of the ancient Roman thermal baths has been recreated!






Day 8 - Monday, 10 March


Day 9 - Tuesday, 11 March
